One cannot be a Christian without believing that Jesus Christ is the Son of God who came down from the Father (John 8:19-25). One cannot be a Christian by simply believing Jesus was a "good man." To be saved (which is to become a Christian), one must believe that Jesus is the only begotten Son of God, repent of his sins, confess his belief that Christ is God's Son, and be baptized into Christ for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38; 8:37; Mark 16:16; 1Pet. 3:21).

Do you believe Jesus is the Christ, the only begotten Son of God? If you do, you are not far from the kingdom. You need only to repent of your sins, confess your faith in Him, and be baptized to become a Christian.

Not All “Believers” Are Christians

Merely believing in Jesus Christ does not make one a Christian. If that were the case, the devils would be Christians (Jam. 2:19).

While it is true that to be a Christian, one must believe in Jesus Christ, mere belief does not make one a Christian. One must be a man to be a husband, but not all men are husbands.

As surely as the Bible is the Word of God, there are millions of people who think they are Christians when they are not. There are multiplied millions who believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, but they are not saved because they have not obeyed Him (Heb. 5:8-9).
