## **One Time**

There is a word in the New Testament that is used several times and means that something was done or happened one time.

Paul was nearly stoned to death one time (2 Cor. 11:25; Acts 14:19-20).

The High Priest under the Law of Moses went into the Most Holy place once a year with blood (Heb. 9:7, 25).

Christ offered His blood one time in order to obtain eternal redemption (Heb. 7:27; 9:12, 26; 10:10).

All men will die one time (Heb. 9:27).

The book of Jude reveals that something else was done "one time."

Jude wrote, "Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints" (Jude 3). What is "the faith" that was once for all delivered? Sometimes the word faith is used to refer to someone's personal conviction on a matter (Rom. 14:22-23). Sometimes it refers to trust (Matt. 8:10). Sometimes it refers to Christians - "the household of faith" (Gal. 6:10).

Jude is not using it in any of these terms. He is using it to refer to the fact that the gospel of Christ had been delivered once and for all. Sometimes the word faith in the New Testament references the gospel of Christ. Acts 6:7 speaks of those who were "obedient to the faith." The Colossians were encouraged to "continue in the faith" (Col. 1:23). Before "the faith came" man was under the jurisdiction of the Law of Moses (Gal. 3:19-25).

What's the point? There are some who would have us believe that God speaks to them today and further reveals His will. Some claim that the Holy Spirit speaks to them. On one occasion a lady told me that Jesus was standing at the foot of her bed talking to her. In spite of all these claims we are told that "the faith," i.e., the gospel has been delivered "once for all" and that was written during the first century. If God were still talking to people today in some way other than through His word, the gospel, Jude was wrong! Not only that, but the Bible tells us in no uncertain terms that God does not show favoritism (Acts 10:34; Rom. 2:11; Gal. 2:6). If God truly were speaking only to some people and not all, He would be showing favoritism! The Scriptures claim for themselves to be the complete revelation of God's will (2 Tim. 3:16-17; 2 Pet. 1:3). God still does speak to mankind today, but it is only through the inspired, written word (Jn. 12:48-50).
