

the unseen spirits) for the Judgment? "And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment" (Hebrews 9:27). Of the eternal separation of that day, Jesus said, "And these (wicked) shall go away into everlasting punishment; but the righteous into life eternal" (Matt. 25:46). "All" will appear before the judgment seat of Christ (II Cor.5:10-11.)

The words of this article are not just new-fangled thoughts! The book of Jude records by inspiration that these warnings were sounded all the way back to Enoch, the seventh from Adam! He prophesied saying, "Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints, to execute judgment upon all and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him. These are murmurers, complainers, walking after their own lusts; and their mouth speaketh great swelling words, having men's persons in admiration of advantage. But, beloved remember ye the words which were spoken before of the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ; how that they told you there should be mockers in the last time, who should walk after their own ungodly lusts. They who separate themselves! Sensual, having not the Spirit. But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit (His teaching). Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. And of some have compassion, making a difference. And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh. Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy, to the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power both now and ever. Amen" (Jude 14-25).
